The projects students will be working on will be varied, and a mix of traditional and modern techniques will be covered. The course is suitable for both beginners and the more experienced and the group will be a mixture of all levels.

This course is to be held at the Oldham Hall in Church St, Great Missenden (approx 8 minute walk from The Abbey). There is limited car parking at The Oldham Hall but students are free to leave their cars at The Abbey should they wish.

Please note that although morning and afternoon refreshments are provided as part of the course fee, lunches are not included. Students are welcome to bring their own or purchase lunch from a selection of local shops, cafes or pubs.

If you are new to this course, we will put you in touch with the tutor prior to the week so that your project and needs can be discussed.
