#### Description

An extraordinary experience working in unison with Jackie Devereux, an artist renowned for her contemporary works on paper - original and experimental in nature, yet carefully crafted. We shall develop ideas through research - trial and error are key. Introducing powerful black Indian Ink (or not!) is always a surprise bonus on Jackie's courses. Jackie is always working and experimenting as she creates work for her exhibitions, and each of her courses has surprise elements.

Permanent BLACK INDIAN INK  
Permanent Fine Liner pen(s)
