Textiles: DIVIDE - REARRANGE - FRAGMENT - STITCH Janet Edmonds

11th - 12th Apr 2026 Saturday to Sunday

This course aims to build designs using contrasting surfaces and to explore a range of stitches to implement them. It is suitable for those wishing to make a unique and personal textile and who would like some help to achieve this. Beginners and the more advanced are both welcome.

Description

A simple accessible design process is an integral element of the course and will give some exciting imagery to develop into a stitched textile. Techniques will include preparing design papers with acrylic paints and inks, working with cut paper to build designs. Composition will consider shape, contrast, and line.

We will explore a range of stitch techniques to make surfaces that will enhance designs made.
